

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-2025**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHEROKEE COUNTY TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NETURAL RATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for Cherokee County, Kansas was calculated as 30.605 mills by the Cherokee County Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Board of County Commissioners for Cherokee County (the "Board") will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board held a hearing on August 25, 2025 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

The County of Cherokee shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 30.605 mills.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Board.
