**Nathan Coleman - County Counselor**


He appeared before the Board regarding legal matters concerning Cherokee County.


He reported that he is working on the Stipville Community Association issue regarding the K-7 Highway project. The court hearing is set for December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2015.




