

MINUTES for December 28, 2022
BOARD of CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'
CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Chairman Cory Moates called the special session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (the Board), to order at 8:30 AM on Wednesday, December 28, 2022, in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. County commissioner Myra Frazier opened the meeting with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners Cory Moates, Lorie Johnson, Myra Frazier, county clerk Rebecca Brassart, county counselor Nathan Coleman, Matt and Gene Mense with the Mense CPA firm were present.

PUBLIC HEARING BUDGET AMENDMENT

Commissioner Moates opened the public hearing regarding the budget amendment of the direct election fund. Commissioner Frazier made a motion to amend the direct election budget from 157,040 to 192,040. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to close the public hearing. Commissioner Frazier seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL of MINUTES

Commissioner Frazier made a motion to approve the minutes as presented from the December 22, 2022, meeting. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Frazier made a motion to approve the payroll as presented. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
