#### **MINUTES FOR DECEMBER 3, 2018**

#### **BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

### **CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS**

### **CONVENE**

Vice-Chairman Neal Anderson called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, December 3, 2018 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Jim Tunnell opened the meeting with prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners Pat Collins, Neal Anderson, County Counselor Barbara Wright, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present. Chairman Cory Moates was absent.

Members of the press present: Larry Hiatt

Brenda Clugston presented personnel documents for the Board's approval. The Board approved the request as presented by the Health Department.

Leonard Vanatta, County Road Supervisor, appeared before the Board on county road business. Leonard reported that they should finish the cleanup on the dump site near Lawton today. Counselor Wright provided Leonard a list of the three properties that are ready for demolition.

The Board discussed reducing the speed limit on SW 20<sup>th</sup> St. adjacent to the Crossland Park. Leonard recommended 20 mph for the first ¼ mile south of the highway, then 30 mph on south to Maple St. The Board requested children present signs also. Counselor Wright will draft a resolution for the Board to review next week.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the minutes of the November 19, 2018 BOCC meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the payroll for the period ending November 23, 2018. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the accounts payable for the period ending November 28, 2018. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to recess for 10 minutes and to reconvene at 10:00 a.m. The motion as seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

At 10:00 a.m. Vice-Chairman Anderson opened the public hearing for the condemnation of properties located at 8931 SE 72<sup>nd</sup> Ter., and 8793 SE 71<sup>st</sup> Ter. Counselor Wright stated that the property located at 8931 SE 72<sup>nd</sup> Ter. has seen activity, but nothing substantial.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to proceed with the drafting of a resolution for the demolition of a structure at 8931 SE 72<sup>nd</sup> Ter. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0.

Counselor Wright stated that regarding the property located at 8793 SE 71<sup>st</sup> Ter., she has spoken with Leonard Vanatta and he is going to make contact with Mr. Wheeler regarding his progress on cleaning up the property. She stated that no action is needed by the Board at this time.

Vice-Chairman Anderson closed the public hearing at 10:03 a.m.

Clerk Edmondson presented a draft amended budget prepared by Gene Mense for the Road & Bridge Department for the Board to consider. The amendment is based on actual and estimated expenses for the remainder of 2018. The amendment sets a public hearing on December 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. for public comments.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the public hearing for the amended Road & Bridge Department's 2018 budget and set the hearing for December 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

Counselor Wright presented draft resolutions setting public hearings on three properties for demolition as recommended by Art Mallory for the Board to consider.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve Resolution 27-2018 setting January 14, 2019 as the date for public hearing regarding condemnation proceedings for a structure located at 8681 SE 71<sup>st</sup> St., Baxter Springs, Kansas. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to approve Resolution 28-2018 setting January 14, 2019 as the date for public hearing regarding condemnation proceedings for a structure located at 10576 NE 30<sup>th</sup> St., Weir, Kansas. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to approve Resolution 29-2018 setting January 14, 2019 as the date for public hearing regarding condemnation proceedings for a structure located at 342 NE Lawton, Rd., Columbus, Kansas. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to enter an attorney client executive session with the Board, Counselor Wright, and Clerk Edmondson for litigation purposes for a period of 10 minutes, to reconvene in the Commission room at 10:25 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0 at 10:15 a.m.

The meeting reconvened at 10:25 a.m.

No action was taken during the executive session.

Larry Hiatt presented a full page advertisement for the Christmas edition of the News Report for the Board to consider.

A motion was made by Commissioner Anderson to approve the advertisement. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0.

Clerk Edmondson informed the Board that all State offices will be closed on Wednesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> for a national day of mourning for the passing of President George H.W. Bush.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to close the courthouse and all administrative offices on Wednesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> in honor of President George H.W. Bush. The motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Anderson made a motion to adjourn until the next regular meeting set for Monday, December 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 2-0 at 10:38 a.m.
