CONVENE

Commissioner Hilderbrand called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order and led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00 AM on Monday, May 18, 2015 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Charles Napier, Pat Collins, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Minutes of the BOCC Meeting for May 11, 2015 as amended. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Napier to approve the Payroll for the month of May, 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hilderbrand. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Accounts Payables for the month of May, 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to purchase a full page ad in the Sentinel Times for Galena Days in the amount of \$300. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

The meeting reconvened at 11:42 AM.


No action was taken during the Executive Session.


