

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2024

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
MODIFYING THE SPEED LIMIT ON NORTHEAST COAL VALLEY ROAD**

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners is responsible for placing and maintaining all traffic control devices on County roads in Cherokee County, Kansas.

WHEREAS K.S.A. 19-101a, 19-212, 8-2002, and 8-1560 authorize the Board of County Commissioners to establish speed limits upon county roads within its jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners hereby resolves:

Section 1. The speed limit on Northeast Coal Valley Road, between 20th and 30th shall be reduced from 55 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour.

Section 2. The Cherokee County Road and Bridge Department shall place or cause to be placed, appropriate signage indicating the established speed limit.
