

RESOLUTION NO. 27-2024

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ADOPTING THE RIVERTON SEWER MAP**

WHEREAS the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners is the governing body of any sewer district created by the Board in Cherokee County, Kansas. K.S.A. 19-27a02.

WHEREAS the Board has the authority to exercise powers of local legislation and administration, in conformance with K.S.A. 19-101a, 19-101b, and 19-101c, and amendments thereto, as may be necessary and convenient for the purpose of providing sewer services and governing the operation and transaction of business of sewer districts.

WHEREAS the Board deems it necessary to establish the location of existing sewer district infrastructure for which the County is responsible for maintaining.

NOW THEREFORE the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners hereby resolves:

Section 1. The Board adopts the Sewer District Map filed with the Cherokee County Register of Deeds in book 624 at page 517, hereinafter referred to as “the Riverton Sewer Map”.

Section 2. The sewer mains recorded on the Riverton Sewer Map by bold black lines, indicated by the legend as “Proposed Sewer” and the manholes recorded by solid black circles, indicated by the legend as “Proposed Manholes” shall constitute the extent of the infrastructure for which the Board and/or the Sewer District is responsible for maintaining in the area provided by such map.

Section 3. The Board nor the Sewer District shall be responsible for maintaining any private sewer line constructed and installed for the purpose of connecting a sewer customer to the sewer system.

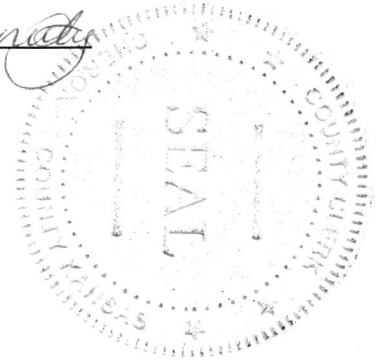
