

RESOLUTION NO. 19-2024

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
FILLING THE VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF COUNTY APPRAISER**

WHEREAS on July 1, 1993, and on July 1 of each fourth year thereafter, the board of county commissioners or governing body of any unified government of each county shall by resolution appoint a county appraiser for such county who shall serve for a term of four years expiring on June 30 of the fourth year thereafter. K.S.A. 19-430(a)(1).

WHEREAS no person shall be appointed or reappointed to or serve as county appraiser in any county under the provisions K.S.A. 19-425, et seq., unless such person shall have at least three years of mass appraisal experience and be qualified by the director of property valuation as an eligible Kansas appraiser under Kansas law. K.S.A. 19-430(a)(1)

WHEREAS whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of county appraiser the board of county commissioners or governing body of any unified government shall appoint an eligible Kansas appraiser to fill such vacancy for the unexpired term. K.S.A. 19-430(a)(2).

WHEREAS a vacancy was created in the office of Cherokee County Appraiser upon the resignation of Appraiser David Thornton, effective December 31, 2023.

WHEREAS the board of county commissioners advertised the vacancy and interviewed multiple candidates to fill such vacancy.

WHEREAS the board of county commissioners finds Delinda White is qualified to serve as Cherokee County Appraiser.

NOW THEREFORE the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners hereby resolves:


Section 1. Delinda White is hereby appointed as Appraiser for Cherokee County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 19-430(a)(2).

Section 2. Delinda White shall serve the unexpired term of County Appraiser expiring on June 30, 2025.

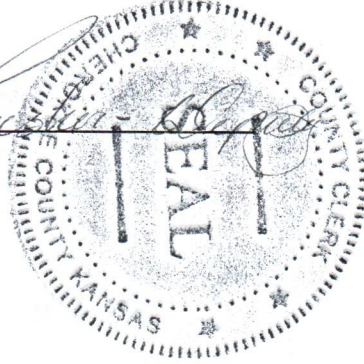
