

RESOLUTION NO. 2-2022

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-101 et. seq., and K.S.A. 19-212 authorize the Board of County Commissioners to transact all County business and perform all powers of local legislation deemed appropriate, and to contract for the protection and promotion of the public health, welfare, and concerns of the county, and to take such actions necessary to the exercise of its corporate or administrative powers; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 48-929 and K.A.R. 56-2-2 directs counties to establish an agency responsible for emergency management and coordination of response to disaster and to appoint an Emergency Management Director; and

WHEREAS, as a result of a vacancy in the position of the Cherokee County Emergency Management Director position, the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas appointed Cherokee County Sheriff as the interim Emergency Management Director pending the appointment of a permanent director.

BE IT RESOLVED and ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, that Jared Glover of Columbus, Kansas be appointed as Cherokee County Emergency Management Director, effective May 2, 2022:


