

MINUTES for November 16, 2022
BOARD of CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'
CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Chairman Cory Moates called the special election canvass session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (the Board), to order at 8:30 AM on Wednesday, November 16, 2022, in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Cory Moates, Lorie Johnson, Myra Frazier, County Clerk Rebecca Brassart, County Counselor Nathan Coleman, Deputy Election Clerk Chelsea Pillar, and the election board for canvass made up of Marcia Trease, Mamie Houser and Toni Spieth were present.

CANVASSING


County Clerk Rebecca Brassart presented the board with 139 provisional ballots. The board rejected 29 accepted 108 to be counted in full and 2 to be partially counted. Commissioner Moates made a motion to accept 108 in full and 2 partially and reject 29 ballots. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with commissioner Frazier abstaining due to being on the ballot.

The provisional ballots were then counted for votes and added to the unofficial primary results. Once the unofficial totals were presented which included the provisional ballot count. Commissioner Moates made a motion to certify the abstract of the election. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously with commissioner Frazier abstaining due to being on the ballot.

ADJOURNMENT of REGULAR MEETING

Commissioner Frazier made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Moates seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
