Notice of Closing of Registration Books Before the

Bond Election Unified School District 499 on April 8, 2025

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2311, notice is hereby given that on the 18th day of March 2025 the books for registration of voters for the Bond Election Unified School District NO. 499, Cherokee County, Kansas (Galena), will close and remain closed until the 9th day of April 2025.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age and upwards or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote.

Voters must bring Valid ID with them to vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceedings or changes residence. The voter must re-register in person, by mail or other delivery when registration is open, or the voter may re-register on election day.

Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer or the Secretary of State upon request. The application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.

Special provision is made for the sick or physically disabled who wish to vote in advance and all other voters who vote in advance must provide photo id.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2908 all registered Kansas voters must provide and show a valid photo id on election day before voting. If no photo id is provided by the registered voter, they will be required to vote a provisional ballot and be required to take a valid photo id to the Cherokee county election officer prior to the canvass of the special election.
