Returning Advance Ballots:

In person ballots must be returned by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day to any Polling Location within the County or to the County Election Office, County Courthouse, 110 W. Maple ST, Columbus, KS 66725. By Mail: Ballot must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, November 7, 2023 (Election Day) and received in County Election Office by Friday, November 10, 2023, the deadline for receipt of Advance Ballots. K.S.A. 25-1132.

Early Voting:

Early voting (In House/In Person) is available at Cherokee County Courthouse (Clerk's Office) Monday-Friday from 7:00am to 5:00pm beginning Wednesday October 18, 2023, through Monday 12:00 Noon, November 6, 2023. K.S.A. 25-1122(g)
