County Treasure Raven Elmore informed THE COMMISSION she had transferred \$79,230.06 from motor vehicle to courthouse fund.


Commissioner Moates moved to approve accounts payable in the amount of \$395,565.55 Commissioner Frazier 2nd the motion, motion passed 3-0.

Discussion on the Voter Register roll.




