At 9:00 a.m. on Monday November 8, 2021, Chairman Moates called the regular session of the Cherokee County Commission to order in room 109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 West Maple, Columbus, Kansas. Commissioner Frazier moved to accept and approve the November 1, 2021, Commission Meeting Minutes for publish. Commissioner Johnson 2nd the motion, motion passed 3-0.

Road & Bridge Report: unavailable.

Commissioner Moates moved to hire J.C. Parsons as the Noxious weed operator at \$16/HR. Commissioner Johnson 2nd the motion, motion passed 3-0.

Baxter Springs ambulance discussion: Commissioner Moates stated Baxter Ambulance donated \$75,000 remaining tax dollars to the Baxter Springs Schools for child- care. The question becomes can Cherokee County retain all or part of those tax dollars? The Commission requested County Council Nathan Coleman research the question.

Commissioner Moates moved to pay the Internal Revenue Service a late fee of \$821.76. Commissioner Johnson 2nd the motion, motion 3-0.


