

Minutes for May 11, 2020
County Board of Cherokee Commissioners
Cherokee County Commissioners

Chairperson Frazier called the regular meeting of the Cherokee County Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Monday May 11, 2020 in courtroom #216 of the Cherokee County Courthouse, located at 110 West Maple, Columbus Kansas. Commissioner Frazier opened with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners Myra Frazier, Neal Anderson, Corey Moates, County Counselor Barbara Wright, and County Clerk, Kyle Rennie were present. Members of the press present Larry Hiatt.

Commissioner Moates moved to amend the May 4, 2020 minutes to read Resolution 13-2020 instead of 14-2020. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Anderson read a report generated by Economic Development Director, Janet Miller on a large number of businesses in the county. The report reflected revenues after the COVID-19 statewide shutdown to be better than expected.

Road & Bridge Supervisor Leonard Vanatta updated THE BOARD on county road conditions.

Commissioner Moates read aloud the National Police Week Proclamation, recognizing all First Responders for their loyal devotion to their responsibilities. Commissioner Moates moved the adoption of the Cherokee County National Police Week Proclamation. (A proclamation calling upon all citizens, civic and patriotic organizations of Cherokee County to observe the week of May 10-16, 2020, as Police Week) Commissioner Anderson 2nd, motion passed 3-0.


Commissioner Anderson moved to add Tele-Med into the county insurance benefit. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Frazier moved to refund \$200 to Jeffrey & Sarah Renn for Property Reference R601 from the February 2020, delinquent property tax sale. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed 3-0.

Commissioner Anderson moved to adjourn until the next regular session May 18, 2020. Commissioner Moates 2nd, motion passed 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 10:57 a.m.
