CONVENE CANVASS

Chairman Cory Moates opened the election canvass session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (the Board), to order on Tuesday, August 13, 2024, in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Cory Moates, Lorie Johnson, Myra Frazier, County Counselor Jake Conard, County Clerk Rebecca Brassart, Deputy Clerk Jess Frasher, and the election board for canvass were present.

CANVASSING


County Clerk Rebecca Brassart presented the board with 115 provisional ballots. The board rejected 26, accepted 88 to be counted in full, and accepted 1 to be counted partially. Commissioner Moates made a motion to accept 88 in full, accept 1 partially, and reject the 26 ballots. Commissioner Frazier seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.




The provisional ballots were then counted for votes by the election board of canvass and added to the unofficial primary results. Once the unofficial totals were presented which included the provisional ballot count, Commissioner Moates motioned to certify the abstract of the election. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
