Upon a motion by Commissioner Corey Moates, with a second by Commissioner Lorie Johnson, and a vote of the full membership of the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, serving as the Official Board of Canvassers, thereon of 3 in approval and 0 opposed, the results of the 2021 General City School Election held on November 2, 2021 are certified as accurate and true after the canvassing of the results. The Board of Cherokee Commissioners consisting of Corey Moats, Lorie Johnson, and Myra Carlisle Frazier have determined that 27 Provisional Ballots were deemed reviewed. The final results were; of the Provisional Ballots 22 shall be counted, and 5 were rejected for not qualifying after further review.

The approved Provisional Ballots were removed from the provisional envelopes by County Clerk Kyle D. Rennie, then hand entered into the vote count in their respective precinct in Cherokee County by the Deputy County Clerk, Jacqueline Perry, on November 15, 2021 under the supervision of the Official County Board of Canvassers, County Clerk Kyle D. Rennie. The Document containing the final results was then submitted to the commission on November 15, 2021 in the weekly meeting of the Board of Commissioners for signatures by the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners.
