

Monday, April 13, 2020 Local Briefing Notes

Locally, we have one active positive case, as the others have all recovered.

Yesterday, the Kansas Department of Health and Environment reported 1,268 positive cases, 293 hospitalizations, 55 deaths and 11,075 negative tests. Today they are reporting 1,337 positives, 298 hospitalizations, 56 deaths and 11,916 negative tests.

The Kansas Department of Labor is having issues with their website and are working to resolve those as well as increase capabilities to process phone calls.

The Army Corps of Engineers have completed their initial survey of alternative care facilities across the state.
