

Thursday, July 2, 2020 Local Briefing Notes

Locally

As of this afternoon, Cherokee County has 13 positive cases, which includes three residents who are hospitalized. There have been 25 residents who had been previously diagnosed and have since recovered. Cherokee County currently has a 44.8 per 1,000 residents test rate. Cherokee County has a positive rate of 1.6 per 1,000 residents.

Statewide

Yesterday the Kansas Department of Health and Environment reported 14,990 positive Covid-19 cases since tracking began, which includes 1,195 statewide hospitalizations and 272 deaths. The state has a testing rate of 62.75 per 1,000 residents with an 8.2% positive rate.

Nationwide

John Hopkins University reports 10,761,214 COVID-19 cases worldwide since tracking began. This includes 517,647 deaths reported globally. Domestically, they report 2,713,195 positive cases, 128,421 deaths and 729,994 recovered.
