

Tuesday, June 9, 2020 Local Briefing Notes

Locally

For the second consecutive day, Cherokee County is reporting a new active positive case. This brings our total to 12 positive cases since tracking began; 10 recovered and 2 active.

Statewide

The Kansas Division of Emergency Management encourages counties to help community colleges with PPE Requests, specifically those community colleges who turned over PPE on-hand at the beginning of the pandemic response.

The National Weather Service predicts over the next couple of hours thunderstorms will develop over north central Kansas, moving north / northeast with potential for hail and tornados. Later this afternoon, a new series of storms in northeastern Kansas is expected.

Hand sanitizer in 55 gallon barrels have been donated and is available through the end of June, from the state.

Nationwide

John Hopkins University reports 7,172,874 COVID-19 cases worldwide since tracking began. This includes 407,818 deaths reported globally. Domestically, they report 1,968,221 positive cases, 111,194 deaths and 518,522 recovered.
