

Sunday, April 5, 2020 Local Briefing Notes

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment, as of the time of this email are reporting 747 positive cases, including 183 hospitalizations and 22 deaths, up from 698 positives cases, 172 hospitalization's and 21 deaths reported yesterday.

The local emergency response team has been working on supply acquisition today.

There was no 1:00 statewide call today, so nothing to report there.

Our numbers in Cherokee County have not changed from yesterday. We have had 5 positives since test tracking started and two of those individuals have since recovered.
