As of the time of this email, Kansas is reporting 319 positive cases and 6 deaths, up from 261 positive cases and 5 deaths yesterday.

During the 1:00 conference call with the state, it was reiterated that businesses who have questions about whether or not they are essential businesses should email KEFF@ks.gov to seek clarification.

If a business seeks clarification and is granted “essential” designation, the county will be notified.

There was a question as to whether or not positive cases at Fort Riley were calculated in the Kansas totals and KDHE said they were.
