RESOLUTION NO. 28-2020

**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS, INCREASING SEWER RATES TO FUND
OPERATIONS AND DEBT SERVICE FOR THE CHEROKEE COUNTY
WASTEWATER SYSTEM.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORITY. K.S.A. 19-101, *et. seq.*, and K.S.A. 19-212 authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, to transact all County business and perform all powers of local legislation deemed appropriate, and to make all contracts and do all other acts in relation to the property and concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate or administrative powers.

SECTION 2. PROJECT AND ADMINISTRATION. Due to increased costs of materials and operations, and the Main Lift Station Project, the Board of County Commissioners of Cherokee County, Kansas, hereby increases sewer rates according to Exhibit #1, attached, effective January 1, 2021.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT. That Cherokee County, Kansas, shall adopt one or more dedicated sources of revenue for repayment of financing, maintenance and equipment replacement. The dedicated sources of revenue may be in the form of user charges, ad valorem taxes, special tax assessments, another permanent source of revenue or some combination of these sources. The County shall conduct a revenue source review each year during the entire life of the sewer system and shall implement new revenue rates to maintain a positive cash balance.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. The County Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published in the official County Newspaper.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. That all resolutions, County policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

**CHEROKEE COUNTY SPECIAL SEWER DISTRICT RATE CHANGES
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2021**

Every single-family residential structure shall be billed as 1 UNIT.

All multiple family residential structures shall be billed 1 UNIT for each residence, e.g., duplex will be 2 UNITS, triplex will be 3 UNITS, etc.

All existing "Other Accounts" will be charged by the number of UNITS assigned using a 12 month water average from 2019-2020, and dividing the monthly average by 4,000 gallons.

New accounts in the "Other Account" category will be estimated by the Board of Commissioners and will be adjusted as necessary within 2 years of the account opening by using a 12 month water average, and dividing the monthly average by 4,000 gallons.

A one UNIT minimum will apply to all accounts.

Beginning with the January 2021 billing cycle the fee for every UNIT will be \$31.00.

Beginning with the January 2022 billing cycle the fee for every UNIT will be \$35.00.

Beginning with the January 2023 billing cycle the fee for every UNIT will be \$39.50.

(Fees for "Other Accounts will be rounded to the nearest \$.50)
