MINUTES FOR JANUARY 12, 2015

BOARD OF CHEROKEE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS

CONVENE

Commissioner Hilderbrand called the regular session of the Cherokee County Board of Commissioners (The Board), to order and led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance at 9:00 AM on Monday, January 12, 2015 in the Commission Room, #109 of the Cherokee County Courthouse located at 110 W Maple St., Columbus, Kansas. Commissioners Richard Hilderbrand, Charles Napier, Pat Collins, and County Clerk Rodney Edmondson were present.

Steve Goehl - D.A. Davidson & Co.

He appeared before the Board to bring an update on the potential refinancing of the jail loan. He is estimating savings of 3.89% with total savings of \$757,000 and reducing the term of the loan by one year.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to move forward with the refinancing of the jail loan, upon recommendation and approval of Gene Mense, with a 3% floor for savings. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Minutes of the January 5, 2015 BOCC Meeting as written. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Commissioner Collins to approve the Mid-Month Accounts Payables for January 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Property Tax Relief Applications - Baxter Springs Tornado

The Board reviewed Property Tax Relief Applications for consideration of tax abatements to homesteads damaged as a result of the tornado in Baxter Springs on April 27, 2014.

The Board reviewed the following applications and made determinations as indicated.

Jeffery & Amanda McKarus, 528 E 10th St. - A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand, seconded by Commissioner Collins to grant a 100% abatement. The motion carried 3-0.

Jeffery & Amanda McKarus, 539 E 9th St. - A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand, seconded by Commissioner Collins to grant a 100% abatement. The motion carried 3-0.

All properties are located within the city limits of Baxter Springs. The abatements granted are for tax year 2014. The approved abatements will apply to property taxes on structures. Land values and taxes assessed on land are not affected.

Nathan Coleman - County Counselor

He appeared before the Board with legal matters concerning Cherokee County.



At 11:32 AM the Board convened as Fence Viewers. Mr. Coleman provided documents from both sides stating their position. Mr. Larry Prauser addressed the Board on behalf of John R. Gaither. Mr. Prauser would like to have a copy of Mr. Roth's written response and be allowed time to respond in writing before the Board makes a decision. Mr. Prauser will submit a written response on January 22, 2015 to the Clerk and County Counsel for the Board to consider at their meeting on January 26, 2015. Phillip A. Roth addressed the Board stating his position.

The Board will render a decision on January 26, 2015.

At 12:00 PM the Board reconvened as the Board of County Commissioners.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hilderbrand to enter an Executive Session with the Board and Mr. Coleman for the purpose of Non/Elected Personnel for a period of five minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 at 12:10 PM.

The meeting reconvened at 12:17 PM.

No action was taken as a result of the Executive Session.

At 12:21 PM the Board recessed to the District Courtroom for the purpose of attending the swearing in of Commissioner Collins as District #1 Commissioner, and Oliver Kent Lynch as District Judge.

The Board will reconvene at 1:45 PM in the Commission Room following a lunch break.

The Board reconvened at 1:45 PM for the annual reorganization for 2015.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Commissioner Hilderbrand as the Board Chair for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Commissioner Napier the Board Vice-Chair for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hilderbrand. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Leonard Vanatta as the County Road & Bridge Supervisor for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Gene Langerot as the County Lot Supervisor for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Kristin Seal as County Noxious Weed Director for 2015 with license renewal to be presented to the Board within 90 days. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to designate the American Bank of Baxter Springs, Columbus, and Galena as the official working bank for Cherokee County for 2015, with all other banks to be recognized as depositories. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Napier made a motion to designate the Columbus News Report as the official County Newspaper for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0.



Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Nathan Coleman as the Legal Counselor to the Board of County Commissioners for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Collins made a motion to appoint Jason Allison as the Emergency Preparedness Director for Cherokee County for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hilderbrand. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to appoint Betha Elliott as the Director of the Cherokee County Health Department for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Napier made a motion to appoint Mense, Churchwell, and Mense as the official Auditing Firm for Cherokee County for 2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to appoint Melanie Bingham, Sam Marsh, Candace Gayoso, and Kevin Cure as court appointed counsels for the District Court, pending the return of the signed contracts. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins. The motion carried 3-0.

The Board set the agenda for the Special Meeting to be held on Tuesday, January 20, 2015. Items to be considered are: Opening and Pledge, Approval of Accounts Payables and Payroll, and consideration of Property Tax Relief Applications from the tornado in Baxter Springs.

The Board approved the renewal of the Mass Notification Service (NIXLE) as presented by Jason Allison, Emergency Preparedness Director, at a cost of \$3,485.00.

Commissioner Hilderbrand made a motion to adjourn until the next scheduled Special Meeting set for January 20, 2015 at 9:00 AM. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Napier. The motion carried 3-0 with all voting yes at 2:19 PM.

The Board will not meet on Monday, January 19, 2015 due to the observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday.
