Shall the following be adopted?

The Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, has determined that the continuation of the sales tax revenue in the amount of one-half of one percent (.5%) is necessary to finance streets within the City; to finance surface water sewer drainage within the City; to finance emergency response services within the City; to finance ADA compliance and renovations to public facilities; to finance maintenance of public lands; and to finance any other projects within the City deemed necessary by the Governing Body; that property tax increases should be avoided if possible. Such tax shall take effect July 1, 2022, subject to Kansas Department of Revenue procedures, and remain in effect until January 31, 2029.
