

Saturday, April 4, 2020 Local Briefing Notes

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment, as of the time of this email are reporting 698 positives cases statewide, including 172 hospitalization's and 21 deaths. This is up from 620 positives, 151 hospitalizations and 17 deaths yesterday.

Nationally, there are 301,902 cases, up from 261,438 yesterday.

Our numbers in Cherokee County have not changed from yesterday. We have had 5 positives since test tracking started and two of those individuals have since recovered.

There was not much discussed during the 1:00 conference call with the state other than a brief discussion regarding the Governor potentially issuing another Executive Order to bring some clarification to the previous EO.
